

Hate Crime - Hate Speech Guide



This guide is to provide a clear definition of what Hate Crime is and types of hate speech.

HATE CRIME

The term 'hate crime' can be used to describe a range of criminal behaviour where the perpetrator is motivated by hostility or demonstrates hostility towards the victim's, race, religion/faith, sexual orientation or transgender/gender identity, disability (Offences (Aggravated by Prejudice) Act 2010).

These aspects of a person's identity are known as 'protected characteristics'. A hate crime can include verbal abuse, intimidation, threats, harassment, assault, and bullying, as well as damage to property. The perpetrator can also be a friend, carer or acquaintance who exploits their relationship with the victim for financial gain or some other criminal purpose.

Faith Hate Crime is when someone picks on you because you are a Muslim, or a Hindu, or a Pagan. If you are a Muslim who is a victim of hate crime, it's called Islamophobia. If you are Jewish (whether you are religious or not), it's called Anti-Semitic Hate Crime.

Homophobia as described by Stonewall is '*the irrational hatred, intolerance and fear of lesbian, gay and bisexual people.*' It is negative attitude and dislike towards homosexuality, people identifying as being lesbian, gay, bisexual, or transgender. It is also disdain, prejudice, antipathy, hatred, or hostility, often based on irrational fear and ignorance, and it is often related to religious beliefs.

HATE SPEECH

Hate speech is any form of communication which expresses hate or encourages violence and intends to harass, alarm or cause distress towards a person or group based on something such as race, religion, sex, or sexual orientation.

The Police and CPS will enforce penalties for hate speech including fines, imprisonment, or in some cases can be both.

ADVICE AND SUPPORT

- We encourage and support all victims of hate crime/speech to report hate crimes/incidents
- We adopt a multi-agency response to dealing with hate crime
- We continually review incidents and crimes to identify current and new trends
